Dear Sir:-

Referring to your cable message received on date of the 10th inst. in which you requested that a duplicate warrant be issued in payment of amount due you by the Territory for services as chairman and secretary of Divisional Road Commission, Road District No. 2, during months of July, August, September and October 1920; original warrant in sum of \$833.32 covering such services having issued and forwarded to you on date of November 13th last.

In reply to your request I wired you on the 10th inst. as follows:

"Warrant for eight hundred thirty-three dollars thirty-two cents issued November thirteenth in settlement of your salary for months of July, August, September and October still outstanding. Cannot issue duplicate however without indemnifying bond which is being forwarded for execution."

Pursuant to the above message, I am enclosing herewith form of bond to be executed by yourself and two good and sufficient sureties. If by the time this bond form reaches you, the original warrant has not come to light, the bond should be properly executed and forwarded to office for issue of the desired duplicate warrant. A duplicate of a lost or missing Territorial warrant can not be issued until the payer furnishes a bond indemnifying the Territory against loss in event the missing warrant turns up and is paid; for this reason it was not possible to comply with the request contained in your wire.

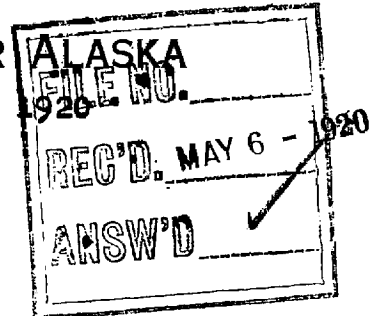
