DEED
UNITED STATES OF AMERICA
STATE OF ALASKA

THIS DEED, made this the 18th day of September, 1965, effective October 1, 1965 by and between the United States of America, party of the first part, acting by and through the Director of the Bureau of the Budget, for and on behalf of the President of the United States of America, and the State of Alaska, party of the second part,

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, section 45(a) of the Alaska Omnibus Act, approved June 25, 1959, 73 Stat. 152, as amended, authorizes the President, if he determines that any function performed by the Federal Government in Alaska has been terminated or curtailed by the Federal Government and that performance of such function or substantially the same function has been or will be assumed by the State of Alaska, to transfer and convey to the State of Alaska, in his discretion, until July 1, 1966, without reimbursement, any property or interest in property, real or personal, situated in Alaska which is owned or held by the United States in connection with such function, the assumption of which function is pursuant to said Act or the Alaska Statehood Act of July 7, 1958, (72 Stat. 339): and

WHEREAS, by Executive Order No. 11230 of June 28, 1965, (30 F.R. 8447), the President delegated to the Director of the Bureau of the Budget the authority vested in him by section 45(a) of the Alaska Omnibus Act (1) to determine that any function performed by the Federal Government in Alaska has been terminated or curtailed by the Federal Government and that performance of such function or substantially the same function has been or will be assumed by the State of Alaska, and (2) in his discretion, to transfer and convey to the State of Alaska, without reimbursement, any property or interest in property, real or personal, situated in Alaska and as otherwise described in section 45(a); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority vested in the President by section 45(a) of the Alaska Omnibus Act, and delegated to the Director of the Bureau of the Budget by Executive Order No. 11230, it is hereby determined that the hereinafter-described property was used by the Federal Government in connection with a function performed by it in Alaska, which function has been terminated, and that performance of substantially the same function has been assumed by the State of Alaska pursuant to the Alaska Statehood Act and the Alaska Omnibus Act;

TALKEETNA, Alaska

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, the Director of the Bureau of the Budget, for and on behalf of the United States of America, thereunto duly authorized, does hereby transfer and convey unto the State of Alaska all right, title, and interest of the United States of America in and to the real and personal property more fully described in Exhibits A and B respectively, attached hereto and made a part hereof; subject to existing easements, recorded and unrecorded, for public roads and highways, public utilities, railroads, and pipelines.

Excepting and reserving, however, to the party of the first part, the right to use without charge, certain tracts of land for as long as the need exists in connection with any functions now being performed by the party of the first part on said lands; which tracts are more fully described in Exhibit C attached hereto and made a part hereof, and

Excepting all title in and to those structures, improvements, and facilities located on the lands as described in Exhibit C; and with the right remaining in party of the first part to grant and convey such structures, improvements, and facilities, as well as other personal property, to the party of the second part in compliance with section 45(a) of the Alaska Omnibus Act, as cited above, at any time prior to July 1, 1966, and thereafter, pursuant to then existing legislation; and

Further reserving all existing power and cable lines, utility lines, and service lines of any kind or description, on the herein conveyed premises; and reserving rights-of-way to service such lines.

There is further reserved to the party of the first part the right to use established streets, highways, or trailways, as they presently exist, as they may be modified hereafter, or as they may exist in the future.


The party of the second part, by acceptance hereof, covenants and agrees for itself and its assigns that, except as may be otherwise provided by law, neither the party of the second part nor its assigns shall, on the ground of race, color, or national origin, discriminate against any person in the United States in connection with the use or disposition of the property hereby conveyed. This covenant shall run with the land hereby conveyed, and shall in any event, without regard to technical classification or designation, legal or otherwise, be binding to the fullest extent permitted by law or equity for the benefit of, or in favor of, the party of the first part, and enforceable by the party of the first part against the party of the second part and its assigns.

TALKEETNA, Alaska

In the event of any breach of the foregoing covenant, the United States shall have the immediate right of reentry upon said property, to take possession thereof, and to hold, own and possess the same as if this conveyance had not been made, and the party of the second part and its assigns shall forfeit all right, title, and interest in said property, and in any and all of the tenements, hereditaments, and appurtenances thereunto belonging. The failure of the party of the first part to insist upon complete performance of said covenant in any one or more instance shall not be construed as a waiver or relinquishment of future performance thereof, but the obligation of the party of the second part and its assigns with respect to such future performance shall continue with full force and effect.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the United States of America, acting by and through the Director of the Bureau of the Budget, who has affixed his name and seal hereto, has caused these presents to be executed in its behalf on this 18th day of September, 1965.
